A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN FOR THE PURPOSE OF SETTING FORTH A COMMITMENT TO OBESITY PREVENTION FOR THE HEALTHY EATING ACTIVE LIVING (HEAL) INITIATIVE WHEREAS, in January 2013, the Maryland Municipal League entered into a memorandum of 1 understanding with the Institute for Public Health Innovation to work collaboratively on the HEAL 2 3 Cities & Towns Campaign; and 4 5 WHEREAS, chronic disease among both children and adults are correlated to environments with few or no options for healthy eating and active living; and 6 7 WHEREAS, one in three youth in Maryland is overweight or obese and more than half of 8 Maryland's adults are overweight or obese and therefore at risk for diabetes, heart disease, cancer, 9 arthritis, stroke, and hypertension; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the City of Aberdeen has the ability to influence healthy choices for its residents; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the City of Aberdeen has the ability to influence planning and construction that 14 encourages walking, biking, and other forms of physical activity; and WHEREAS, supporting the health of residents and the local workforce would decrease chronic 17 disease and health care costs and increase productivity. 18 19
